

Fire Extinguisher, Fire Hose Reel & Fire Blanket Training MSMWHS212

Course Outline

To prevent injury and reduce fire damage, all employees should be trained in the safe use of fire extinguishers, fire hose reels and fire blankets. This training course includes a theory and practical component to ensure that your employees can safely handle workplace emergencies.

To ensure maximum benefit, this training course should be conducted with Fire Warden and Evacuation Training. If required, a Fire Safety Trainer can visit your workplace to determine your fire safety equipment and training needs.

Course Subjects

- Raising the alarm
- •Fire safety and evacuation
- •Classes of fire
- •Types of fire extinguishers
- ·Safety procedures when fighting fires
- •How to use a fire extinguisher, fire hose reel and fire blanket
- •Fire fighting tactics

Participants will gain hands-on experience fighting a real fire with fire fighting equipment. They will also be instructed in correct fire fighting tactics and safety procedures.

Course Delivery & Duration

Classes commence at 8:30am and finish at 11:30am. All students are required to be present 15 minutes before course commencement time. Late arrivals may be refused from the course as a failure to attend.

Training occurs at Eagle Training Services NT training facilities located in Darwin & Alice Springs. Participants undertake the course in comfortable, air-conditioned classrooms with the latest IT and audiovisual capabilities. Students are supported through the provision of high quality learning materials and resources.
