TLI41218 - Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport - Car Driving Instruction)

Course Outline

This course is for people who want to work as driving instructors and train and assess learner drivers or set up a driving training establishment.

As a driving instructor, you will be required to:

- Supervise learner drivers on public roads under a range of unpredictable circumstances due to the variability of the traffic
- Ensure the quality of the driving of the learner drivers and their safety while on public roads
- Train learner drivers on how to develop and maintain safe driving strategies
- Work individually and communicate with clients from diverse backgrounds
- Assist learner drivers in obtaining an Australian drivers licence

Units of Competency

TLI41218 Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport – Car Driving Instruction) contains 12 core units of competency. To obtain this qualification you must successfully complete all 12 units.

Course Fee

The full cost of this course is \$2,700. A \$400 deposit is required upon enrolment. A place on the course is not guaranteed until a client's enrolment has been received, the entry requirements are fully met and the payment of the course deposit fee or an authorised purchase order has been provided. The course cost does not include NT MVR licensing fees.

Confirmation of enrolment

A student's position on the course will be confirmed upon payment of a course deposit fee or the provision of an authorised purchase order. Positions are limited so confirmed enrolments only will be able to attend.

Course Entry Requirements

To be eligible to undertake this course, each prospective student must:

- Hold a current Northern Territory driver licence (not learner or provisional) for the Class in which they wish to instruct
- Be 18 years of age or over;
- Have held a car driver licence in the Northern Territory or anywhere for a continuous period of 3 years immediately prior to making application;
- Be of a good character (fit and proper) by providing a satisfactory National Police Clearance check and a Complete Traffic History check. Both checks are to be undertaken by Northern Territory Police, issued within six weeks prior to date of endorsement application, or as varied in writing by the Regulator;
- Be medically fit (a medical examination is required where evidence of a recent check within six months prior to date of endorsement application cannot be provided); and
- Complete and pass the literacy assessment developed for this purpose and conducted by Eagle Training Services NT.

Training Delivery

Theory training occurs at Eagle Training Services NT training facilities. Students undertake the theory component in comfortable temperature regulated classrooms with the latest IT and audio-visual resources. All vehicle used in practical training are fitted with dual controls for maximum safety. The student's learning is supported with the provision of high quality learning materials and resources.

This training will be delivered in small groups in a face-to-face format, and will consist of theoretical and practical work. The class room based instruction involves power point presentations, interactive scenarios and role play along with verbal question and answer.

The practical sessions will be conducted from the training facility each day. Vehicles are fitted with dual controls and are either manual or automatic and seat the instructor and 3 passengers. There is one instructor dedicated to three students for the practical sessions. Students should be aware that prior to any practical driving tuition/assessment, they may be subject to an Alcohol Screening test. Under the provisions of the Service Provider Deed with the Licence Regulator (MVR), for the delivery of TLI41218 Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport – Car Driving Instruction), students may be subject to a monitoring Audit. Attendance at all sessions is required.
