Low Voltage Rescue with CPR

Course Outline

This course is aimed at individuals working in the electrical industry who wish to gain low voltage switchboard rescue and resuscitation skills for their workplace.

The course is specifically designed for participants requiring qualifications as Safety Observers for live low voltage switchboard work.

A person completing this course is able to conduct a Low Voltage Rescue of a victim and carry out Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).

Course Subjects

- Safety practices including hazard identification and risk control
- Safe Approach Distances (SAD's)
- Low voltage injuries
- Performing low voltage rescue
- DRABCD action plan including incident approach and patient assessment
- Managing the unconscious casualty
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Understand the use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED)

Course Delivery & Duration

Classes commence at 8:30am and finish at 3.30pm.

All students are required to be present 15 minutes before course commencement time. Late arrivals may be refused from the course as a failure to attend.

Training occurs at Eagle Training Services NT training facilities located in Darwin & Alice Springs. Participants undertake the course in comfortable, air-conditioned classrooms with the latest IT and audiovisual capabilities. Students are supported through the provision of high quality learning materials and resources.

Course Assessment

Practical assessment with group interaction. Participants must demonstrate competency during a series of practical skills evaluation and verbal assessments including observation, questioning, and problem solving.

Units of Competency

Participants who successfully complete all components of the course will be issued a Statement of Attainment for the UETDRRF06B Perform rescue from a live LV panel and HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation units of competency.

Welfare and Support Services

Eagle Training Services NT provides welfare and support services within its professional capacity. Clients should identify existing needs prior to enrolment so that appropriate arrangements are made. Where additional support is required, the client will be referred to a specialist agency to access appropriate support. Course Fees
