Course Outline

A first aid course is invaluable when you consider that it could make the difference to someone's life or death. The time and money it costs to complete a first aid course is priceless.

First aid training provides simple advice on how to manage emergency situations and explain first aid techniques and treatments for the most commonly encountered illnesses and injuries.

Accidents happen without warning but with first aid training and first aid supplies you will be able to care for a stranger, family member or close friend who requires assistance.

This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support and the management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

Course Subjects

- Assess an emergency situation
- DRSABCD action plan and recovery position
- Causes and management of the unconscious patient
- Perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Minor wounds and the application of infection control procedures
- Manage external bleeding and shock
- Burns and electric shock
- Eye injuries and soft tissue injuries
- Head, chest and abdominal injuries
- Manage a casualty suffering extremes of temperature
- Venomous bites and stings and allergic reactions
- Spinal injuries and fractures

Course Delivery & Duration

Classes commence at 8:30am and finish at 4:00pm on both days. All students are required to be present 15 minutes before course commencement time. Late arrivals may be refused from the course as a failure to attend.

Training occurs at Eagle Training Services NT training facilities located in Darwin & Alice Springs. Participants undertake the course in comfortable, air-conditioned classrooms with the latest IT and audio-visual capabilities. Students are supported through the provision of high quality learning materials and resources.

Course Assessment

You will be assessed throughout the course to show your instructor that you have an appropriate understanding of the procedures necessary to manage a life-threatening situation. Eagle Training Services NT use scenarios to demonstrate how to assess the scene of an accident and how to assess the casualty to determine if their condition is life threatening. In these mock situations you are required to use the knowledge you have learnt and administer immediate first aid to help the casualty survive.

Welfare and Support Services

Eagle Training Services NT provides welfare and support services within its professional capacity. Clients should identify existing needs prior to enrolment so that appropriate arrangements are made. Where additional support is required, the client will be referred to a specialist agency to access appropriate support. Eagle Training Services NT has a documented policy regarding access and equity.

Course Fees

\$180 per student. Payment in full, or provision of a purchase order is required to secure a place on a course. Course fee is fully refundable only if course is cancelled. This price includes all study manuals and materials.

Confirmation of Enrolment

Payment in full, or provision of a purchase order is required to secure a place on a course. Positions are limited so confirmed enrolments only will be able to attend. For cancellations/refunds, a minimum of 3 business days notice must be provided to Eagle Training Services NT prior to the commencement of the scheduled course to enable re-allocation of your place to another participant, otherwise the full course fee will be payable. Replacements are allowed provided they have Eagle Training Services NT approval before the start of training and course prerequisites are met.
