Eagle Training Services NT has undertaken a re-registration audit in 2016 with ASQA. Where noncompliances occurred we took the opportunity to make amendments and improve on current practices. Eagle Training Services NT is currently registered until March 2023. Our organisation embraces audits as it provides an opportunity to have our training business examined so that we may improve processes and service delivery to our clients.

All accredited training is issued in accordance with the Australian Qualifications Framework.

Eagle Training Services NT does not have any legal action pending.
